80 <b>Chateau DuTertre, Margaux Grand Cru 2011, France</b>	28	37	110
A very appealing nose of ripe, fresh black summer fruits and on the palate, cassis and loganberry meld together with silky tannins, giving a velvety texture. In addition to the fruit, there is a backbone of firm tannins and acidity. An elegant, masculine wine and an excellent example of classic Margaux.			
81 <b>Cante Cigale, Chateauf-neuf-du-pape 2012, France</b>	17	24	70
This wine has lots of warm red fruit and damson aromas, with cinnamon, spices and jam but also concentration on the palate; then liquorice richness and elegance to finish.			
82 <b>Pierre Boureee, Gevry Chambertain 2012, France</b>	20	29	85
Delicate sweet strawberry fruit, fresh acidity and a clean, vibrant palate. A restrained style, with elegance and a delicate redcurrant, raspberry aroma. The palate is fresh and pure with a vibrant backbone of acidity and light red berry fruit.			
83 <b>La Chapelle de Calon 2010, St Estephe AC France</b>	19	27	80
This is the third wine of possibly one of the best wines not only of St Estephe, but maybe Bordeaux itself. With Calon Segur 2010 reaching over £100 per bottle. It makes the second wine from the same soils and younger grapes, made exactly the same way great value.

3 <b>J.M Gremillet Brut Champagne (IWSC Silver 2014)</b>	40
This award winning Champagne delivers on all fronts, the fine mousse in the glass and fresh floral aromas follow through to rich fruit flavours and a fresh crisp citrus finish on the palate.	
4 <b>Moet et Chandon</b>	60
The recent release is all soft and cuddly, and certainly made to please. With yeasty, toasty aromas practically bursting out of the glass, the palate is rather creamy with a little zippy acid on the finish.	
9 <b>Moet et Chandon Rose</b>	65
The aromas are intense and irresistible, a lively bouquet of fresh red summer berries (strawberry, raspberry and red currant) with floral nuances (rose, hawthorn) and a light peppery touch.	
5 <b>Veuve Cliquot NV, France</b>	70
This classical dry Champagne is a blend of two-thirds black grapes (Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier) for body, balanced with one-third Chardonnay for elegance. It has a fine persistent sparkle and golden Champagne color.	
6 <b>Ruinart Brut</b>	80
Golden yellow colour with a beautiful brilliance. Very good mousse and fine bubbles. A delicate, fresh, and fruity nose, showing notes of white fruits mainly pear. Well-balanced, with aromas of ripe fruits. A pleasant, lengthy finish.

Their finest vintage to date, the 2006 (85% Merlot and 15% Cabernet Franc) exhibits an inky/ruby/purple color in addition to a bouquet of smoke, blackberries, and ripe cherries, refreshing acidity, good definition, and a long finish.

76 <b>Hospices de Beaune Corton Grand Cru 2008, France</b>	45
This is garnet-purple of medium depth, with very fresh aromas, including cherry, plum and raspberry. The palate is full-bodied and structured.	
77 <b>Hospices de Beaune Corton Vergennes 2007, Cuvee Paul Chanson</b>	45
The white wine has fruit intensity, with its own, exciting mineral character, finishing fresh, rich and very long.	
79 <b>Hospice de Beaune Pommard 2007, France</b>	60
Colour is medium red-purple, the nose being ripe, with freshness. On the palate, a full start leads into a middle-palate and a rich, gently tannic, beautiful farewell.	

7 <b>Ruinart Rose</b>	90
The wine is a brilliant orange-yellow rose petal colour with a very fine, profuse and sustained mousse. The nose is characterized by small red berries, mainly currant. On the palate the wine is vigorous and well balanced. A fine, fresh, fruity wine with well-integrated tannins and a hint of spice on the lengthy finish.	
8 <b>Dom Pérignon</b>	180
Light minerally with a little bit of sweet spice, citrus galore and so much oyster water on the nose. The palate is unctuous with lots of pencil lead, some lemon pith with a coating of honey and oranges too.

<i>(The Wine Merchant Top 2014)</i> A wonderfully complex multi-layered organic white from Catalonia. A delicate floral nose with white stone fruit, grapefruit and an earthy clay note. The palate has more stonefruit and citrus, with more precise flavours of pear and melon and minerality, with warm spice and savoury notes.		
17 <b>Albarino Orballo 2014</b> , <i>Rias Baixas</i>	<b>27</b>	
<i>(Decanter Awards – Bronze!)</i> Intense aromatics, generous on the palate. The ripe fruit and minerality all balanced by a refreshing burst of acidity.		
18 <b>K Naia 2014, Verdejo-Sauvignon</b> , <i>Rueda, Spain</i>	<b>26</b>	
<i>(Sommelier Wine Awards Silver 2014)</i> A first vintage of Verdejo, Viura and Sauvignon. Aromatic aromas of opulent tropical fruit, passion fruit, kiwi and guava. Racy acidity with long finish.		
19 <b>Diez Siglos Rueda Verdejo 2015</b> , <i>Rueda</i>	<b>21</b>	
<i>(Sommelier Wine Awards Silver 2014)</i> Complex aromas of fresh grass, nettle and passion fruit, tangerine oil and citrus. A rounded and complex palate, delicately mirroring the nose, with savoury hints and bitter marmalade to finish. Vibrant wine from one of Rueda's best producers.		
20 <b>Vetiver Rioja 2014</b> , <i>Rioja Baja</i>	<b>26</b>	
<i>(Sommelier Wine Awards Gold 2014)</i> Award Winning white Rioja, Subtle floral hints, followed by a voluptuous mouth-feel of tropical fruit, white pepper and toast characters. Well balanced, with fine, natural acidity.

45 <b>Mesneros de Castilla Roble 2013</b>	<b>29</b>	
<i>Ribera del Duero</i> A generous and approachable wine with aromas of black cherry, plum and coffee bean. Layered rich fruit with sweet vanilla and toasty notes from some time in oak. Good length and supple tannins give an ample, richly-flavoured finish.		
46 <b>Catalan Eagle Red, Garnacha Cariñena</b>	<b>29</b>	
<b>Syrah Cabernet 2014</b> Characterized by smoky, black berry fruit and spice, rounded off by some contact with French oak this wine has a new world feel while remaining firmly and typically Spanish with the 60% old Grenache and Carignan.		
47 <b>Macia Batle Crianza Binissalem 2012</b> ,	<b>35</b>	
<i>Binissalem, Mallorca, (International Wine Challenge 2012 – Gold!)</i> Powerful and spicy aromas of red and black fruit fill the nose. The palate is rich smooth and beautifully balanced with smoky undertones and well structured finish.		
48 <b>Ontañón Rioja Reserva 2005, Tempranillo</b> , <i>Rioja</i>	<b>35</b>	
Great depth of flavour and fruit - a beautifully structured wine. Deep, dark fruit flavours combined with ample acidity, minerality and earthy notes. It has a fine structure and natural grape tannins to give good length and weight.		
49 <b>Tres Picos, Borsao Garnacha 2013</b> , <i>Campo de Borja</i>	<b>35</b>	
The palate is rich and well structured the intense flavours combining with a sweet tannins following through to a generous and balanced finish.		
50 <b>Don Jacobo, Rioja 2011</b> ,	<b>35</b>	
Don Jacobo Crianza Rioja Tinto is a traditional red Rioja very much in Bodegas Corralis style, matured for a minimum of 12 months in oak followed by at least a year in bottle before release. 90% Tempranillo with small additions of the traditional Garnacha and Mazuelo varieties. A traditional red Rioja, smooth vanilla oak and lovely strawberry and cream Tempranillo fruit. We pop a bit of Garnacha and Mazuelo in to the blend as complex, intense and spicy with developing toast, plums and cherries.		
51 <b>Don Jacobo, Rioja Tiato Viticultura Ecologica, Bedegas Corral Rioja</b> ,	<b>35</b>	
Rioja made from an equal blend of sustainable and organically farmed Tempranillo and Mazuelo grapes. Shows aromas of ripe cherry, plum and blackberry with notes of savoury, liquorice spice; the palate is bright and fresh with sweet, ripe fruit and again a note of spice.		
52 <b>Valenciso Reserva Rioja 2009</b> , <i>(Sommelier Wine Awards 2012 – Bronze!, Decanter WW Awards – Bronze! Sommelier Wine Awards Fine Wine of the Year 2014)</i>	<b>45</b>	
A beautifully elegant, subtle and classically structured Rioja. The palate is soft with real depth of flavour and the classic combination of ripe red berry fruit, cedary oak and fine tannins.

23 <b>Naude 2008</b> , <i>South Africa</i>	<b>26</b>	
Perfect balance of Old World complexity and elegance, and New World fruitiness and structure.		
24 <b>MOKO black Sauvignon Blanc 2015</b> ,	<b>26</b>	
<i>New Zealand, Marlborough</i> Zesty citrus with white stone fruits. Hints of gooseberry rolling into a full layered palate finishing with a lovely balance of texture, weight and a clean refreshing finish.		
25 <b>Bellefontaine Chardonnay, Pays d'Oc 2013</b> , <i>France</i>	<b>24</b>	
An unoaked Chardonnay that is clean, fresh and full of flavour. Ripe and aromatic pear with a touch of fresh peach, fresh and zingy in the mouth starting off with gummy mineral tones then getting fuller and peachier, quite concentrated fruit flavour but balanced by crisp acidity.		
26 <b>Sancerre La Pre Semele 2015</b> , <i>Loire, France</i>	<b>29</b>	
A classic Sancerre with ripe gooseberry fruit and zesty acidity. The style is full and round yet fresh an well-balanced.		
27 <b>Domaine de la Motte Chablis 2014</b> ,	<b>30</b>	
<i>Burgundy, France (WSC French Wine Producer of the Year 2013)</i> Classic un-oaked Chardonnay from the famous village. Pungent and flinty on the nose with creamy fruit underneath which gives way to fruity core.		
28 <b>Domaine des Persecons Saint-Véran 2014</b> ,	<b>45</b>	
<i>Burgundy, France (Sommelier Wine Awards 2014 Gold &amp; Food Match)</i> From the cooler 2012 vintage, this has vibrant citrus fruit, complex minerality and poise. It is a truly good example of a traditional white Burgundy and a delicious food accompaniment.		
29 <b>Mersault Vallet Freres 2013</b> , <i>Burgundy, France</i>	<b>55</b>	
<i>(WSC French Wine Producer of the Year 2012)</i> A heady, lightly oaky but seductive nutty bouquet. The palate is pretty fat and buttery but cut with toasty hazlenut flavours and long mineral balance.

<i>Navarra Spain (Decanter World Wine Awards 2008 – Bronze).</i> A naturally sweet Moscatel which is fresh, clean and has a gentle sweetness, the nose is intense and aromatic, the palate full and delicately sweet.

Fine, supple & intensely satisfying Merlot from Bordeaux. Named after a prominent French restaurateur.		
54 <b>Monte Vista Merlot 2014</b> , <i>Valle Maule, Chile</i>	<b>24</b>	
A wine with poise, elegance and restraint. The palate has lots of plum, as well as herbal notes and a lovely jammy finish. It is light and has a lovely purity and freshness, with a hint of spice.		
55 <b>Bats Blood Merlot</b> , <i>Transylvania</i>	<b>25</b>	
A delicious award winning Merlot, from the heart of Transylvania made with one single delicious Merlot grape, bursting with flavours of soft forest fruits and as smooth as velvet, soft mild plummy notes.		
56 <b>Soldier's Block Langhorn Creek 2015 Shiraz</b> , <i>Australia</i>	<b>29</b>	
Bright and lifted blockbuster shiraz from Langhorne Creek. The palate has a very silky mouthfeel with mulberry, blackberry and a hint of sour cherry. There is a touch of vanilla, as well as some freshness and an elegant finish.		
57 <b>Fleurie, La Madone, La Reine, de l'Arenite 2015</b> , <i>Beaujolais, France</i>	<b>29</b>	
Perfumed aromatic and with a notable floral twist, with an abundance of strawberry and raspberry flavours. Light soft and very easy to drink!

<i>(Sommelier Wine Awards 2014 Gold &amp; Food Match)</i> A wine with style. Instead of the cooked jammy style, this wine has a nose of intense ripe damson, smoke and spices with a sweet silky palate including notes of cherry and a tang of savoury. Generous, with a great structure, the true expression of Piemonte!		
60 <b>Pablo Y Walter 2015, Malbec</b> , <i>Argentina</i>	<b>30</b>	
A celebration of Mendoza - the colour, culture and flavour and a celebration of friendship. A really pure expression of Malbec, bright red & juicy, rich chocolate flavours with a lick of oak to round out the edges.		
61 <b>Barolo Alasia 2011</b> , <i>Italy</i>	<b>40</b>	
Light red colour with hints of orange, nose is complex and spicy. Rich, full bodied with sweet tannins - dry finish
